TRAM	<b>Tram</b> +  Edinburgh Trams	<b>St Andrew Square to Ingliston Park&amp;Ride</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 50 mins (inc. 20 min walk)

BUS	<b>98</b> Lothian	<b>Haymarket to RHS (East Entrance)</b> Journey time: 25 mins
TRAM	<b>Tram</b> +  Edinburgh Trams	<b>Haymarket to Ingliston Park&amp;Ride</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 40 mins (inc. 20 min walk)

## EDINBURGH PARK STATION

BUS	<b>97</b> Lothian	<b>Edinburgh Park Station to RHS (East Entrance)</b> Journey time: 15 mins
TRAM	<b>Tram</b> +  Edinburgh Trams	<b>Edinburgh Park Station to Ingliston Park&amp;Ride</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 30 mins (inc. 20 min walk)


## EDINBURGH GATEWAY STATION

BUS	<b>97</b> Lothian	<b>Edinburgh Gateway Station to RHS (East Entrance)</b> Journey time: 10 mins
TRAM	<b>Tram</b> +  Edinburgh Trams	<b>Edinburgh Gateway Stn to Ingliston Park&amp;Ride</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 25 mins (inc. 20 min walk)

## EDINBURGH AIRPORT

 follow **Yellow walking route** to East Entrance

BUS	<b>AIR</b> +  Citylink	<b>Buchanan Station to Airport Hotels</b> follow <b>Yellow walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 1h 10 mins (inc. 10 min walk)
TRAIN	<b>Train</b> Scotrail	<b>Glasgow Queen St Stn to Edinburgh Park Stn</b> then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Stn Journey time: 1h 20 mins

## STIRLING CENTRE

BUS	<b>X38</b> +  First	<b>Stirling Bus Stn to A8 (Ingliston Road)</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 1hr 55 mins (inc. 7 min walk)
BUS	<b>909</b> +  Citylink	<b>Stirling Bus Stn to A8 (Ingliston Road)</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 50 mins (inc. 7 min walk)
TRAIN	<b>Train</b> Scotrail	<b>Stirling Stn to Edinburgh Park Stn</b> then check travel information from Edinburgh Park Stn Journey time: 1h 05 mins

## HALBEATH & FERRYTOLL PARK&RIDE

BUS	<b>747</b> +  Stagecoach	<b>Halbeath or Ferrytoll P&amp;R to A8 (Ingliston Road)</b> then follow <b>Green walking route</b> to East Entrance Journey time: 35 to 45 mins (inc. 7 min walk)

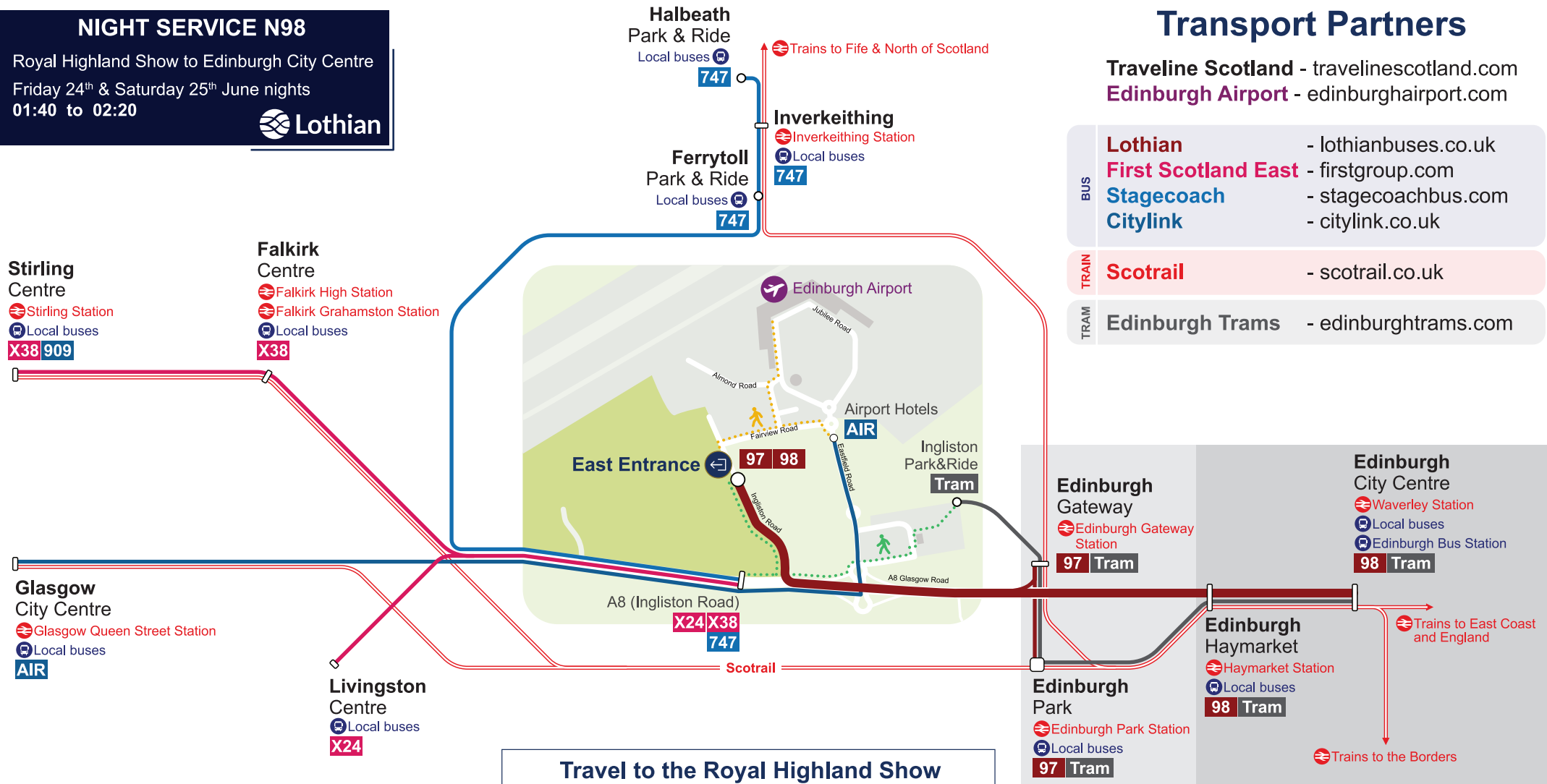
Journey times and service frequencies above are door to door, shown as a guide only and are subject to traffic conditions. Please allow extra time to travel.
