Design a **mosaic panel** for a Lothian bus that answers the following question:

└ **How can young people lead the way in creating a safer Edinburgh?**

Your Task

Create a design that:

- Encourages people to act responsibly and to make safe, positive choices
- Gives young people a voice
- Shows how we can support and look after each other
- Shows what helps young people to feel safe, included and valued.
- Promotes respect and kindness
- Highlight that it's everyone's job to work together to build a safer Edinburgh

Design Spec

- Create your design on A4 or A3 (suggested) and it will be resized to fit.
- You can create it digitally or by hand (felt tip pens and paint recommended)
- Keep your message clear and easy to understand at a glance (people will see it quickly on a bus)
- Use bold colours and strong contrasts so it stands out from a distance
- Include simple images or symbols rather than too much text
- Consider using positive imagery (e.g. teamwork, community, friendship)
- Ensure your design is appropriate for public display.

Strapline

Straplines help to make messages more memorable. If you can, we'd like you to think of a short, catchy phrase to go with your design. If you have an idea, include it with your submission!

What to submit

- Each school can submit a class entry, individual entries or both.
- Submissions must be PDF's either created digitally or scanned from paper.
